Current Projects

- Gradeuxity – education initiative that boosts incentive for high-school students to graduate by awarding them a \$50 check in a booklet of life-skills (meets: 3rd Monday of the month)
- 4 pub crawl fundraisers: Leprecrawl in March (meets: 4th Tuesday of the month), Crawfish Crawl in May (meets: 2nd Wednesday of the month), Corset Crawl in July (meets: 3rd Wednesday of the month) and Bridal Crawl in September (meets: 4th Wednesday of the month)
- Creative Resource Directory - publication, website, and app that provides reinforcement to the local creative and cultural economy (meets: every other Saturday at 10AM)
- Fauxmosa - craft mocktail menus to improve beverage options for non-drinkers and moderate drinkers in social settings (meets: 1st Tuesday of the month)
- Nolalit – New Orleans themed book club that celebrates and reinforces local culture with profound literature and related field trips (public meeting: 2nd Monday of the month)
- Artventure – interactive art walk that showcases our arts district and exposes youth to the arts (meets: 2nd Thursday of the month)
